The Ewha Womans University Alumnae Association of North America (EWUAANA) is in seeking talented students who may be in need of financial support for the academic year, 2020-2021.

Applications are opened to Ewha Womans University undergraduates, graduates or children of Ewha Alumnae in North America who expect to attend an accredited institution of higher education in North America during the grant year or recent Ewha graduates who are doing research or pursuing other scholarly or artistic projects in North America.

Additionally, a scholarship for college or graduate school Korean-born students who have been adopted by parents residing in North America will be available as long as the funding lasts. This scholarship was established by the family of Dr. C.D. Kwon in his memory.

Applicants must be able to submit evidence of: (1) good academic or artistic achievement and promise; (2) financial need; and (3) sound character and commitment to science and/or the arts, including liberal arts.

Applications must adhere closely to the following rules.

1. Applications must be typed and completely filled out. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
2. Submit all required documents described on page 7 of the application.
3. If you require additional space to complete any parts of a section, please use additional space.
4. No applications will be returned to the applicant. EWUAANA reserves the right to publish or reprint any essays submitted as part of an application.
5. Applications may be submitted via email to hshorack@san.rr.com or mailed to the address on page 7, postmarked no later than August 31, 2020.

1. An essay, typed and double-spaced, which explains your motivation to seek the degree or complete the project for which you are requesting assistance. Your essay should also elaborate on the personal attributes which you feel qualify you for this degree or to complete the project, your need for financial aid and your efforts to assist yourself.
2. Two letters of recommendation from someone other than a relative commenting on your character and standing in the community. The letters of recommendation should be completed on letterhead, signed and mailed directly to us from the author. We will disqualify letters that are sent to us from the applicant. Letters from professors who have had students in their classes are desirable.
3. An official copy of your most recent college/graduate school transcript. New graduate students should submit copies of final undergraduate transcripts. Beginning college students should submit a copy of high school transcripts.
4. A written confirmation from the college/graduate school which you will be attending stating that you are in good standing and eligible to be enrolled for work toward the degree you are pursuing.
5. Curriculum vitae (max. 2 pages)
6. Additional requirements for music, arts, design or film students; send one of the following:
 - * 10 pieces of work on USB with the list including titles, dimension and medium or
 - * 1 Short CD
